#### Next meeting October 5



### Elise Anzini October 8

Elise Anzini lived most of her childhood in upstate New York in a haunted house



where she developed her skills at turning eggshells into art. Her family then moved to Orange County, NY, and, in order to escape the oppressive Orange County Choppers Cult, Elise fled to Philadelphia and attended Moore College of Art and Design, graduating in 2012 with a BFA in Illustration. Elise considers herself more of a traditional pysanky artist, though her schooling lends to the brighter color palette on her eggs. She is employed part time by the Easter Bunny during the Lenten season.



The presentation will be on the art of Ukrainian Eggs (Pysanky). It will begin with a short history of the craft and include Elise's techniques and tips on the egg decorating process. The presentation will also touch briefly on the use of Etsy.
