Nature and travel photograph, Patricia S. Worley is president of Twilight Blue Photography. She is the resident artist and curator of the Hansen Warner Building Gallery located on 6 South Main Street in Medford, NJ where she is credited with an early 20 different exhibitions since 2010.

A list of major exhibits includes: The Great American West, African Adventure, Dusk 'till Dawn, Floral Wonders, Rust to Roses, Lands Near and Far, Everyday Faces—China 2010 and Flora of the NJ Pine Barrens.

Pat is also curator for the South Jersey Camera Club, All About Nature juried exhibition and the Hammonton Arts Center rotating exhibit at Atlantic Medical Imaging, AtlantiCare in Hammonton, NJ.

Her most recent notable awards include a Gold Medal and two ribbons in the 2016 Wilmington Exhibition of International Photography, Wilmington, Delaware. In addition, Pat's photography hangs in various AtlantiCare locations, Penn Presbyterian Pavilion for Advanced Care and in numerous private collections. Pat is a graduate of Seton Hall University with a BA in Film and Television, She regularly serves as a photography instructor, presenter and judge throughout the region.

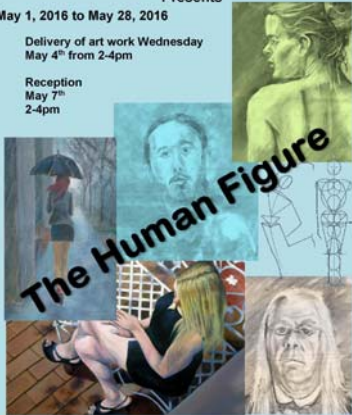

This class is for either cell phone, or digital camera. We will review the basics of composition and exposure. We will make sure each student is familiar with the controls and options in their device. We will be taking pictures in all of the formats listed above. The use of the histogram and filters to adjust exposure will be demonstrated. We will discuss composition and subject matter. The basic exposure and image adjustment tools in Photo editing software will also be demonstrated. Students will learn how to scale images for the best results and correctly save images for printing.
