Additionally, Pat had two of her figure works included the recent WAA Human Figure Show at the 28 East Gallery in Burlington City. "I'm so grateful that the WAA has so many opportunities for members to show their work! Pat was also happy to have her recent work "Georgic: Patterson Farm" juried into the New Hope Art League 7th Annual Juried Show May 20-22. "With this new work, I hope to promote inquiry into the many ways we relate to farmland now. The farms I paint are "small" family farms in comparison to those now managed by mega corporations. While some people still work directly with the land of course, most people are oblivious to the machinations of farming and food productions. The family farm sadly is a dying species. For most Americans, farms are most alive in our imaginations, in the stories and images we string together as we construct in our minds an image of our country. This is a complicated story, of course, one without a clear narrative. I mean to call attention to the farm, not just as an observable landscape, but as the ephemeral image that we manipulate in our minds." In May, Pat participated in the Burlington City Plein Air Paint Out sponsored by the 28 East Gallery in Burlington City. "Burlington City is an exceptional venue for painters, rich in history and beautiful architecture. It was delightful to paint in there, and to meet many of the residents who were so friendly and supportive!" The paint out, designed and organized by gallery owner Melanie Pease, was part of the Home and Garden Tour which occurred on Sunday, May 22. All of the plein air paintings created by 15 artists will be on exhibit opening June 4th at 6 to 8 pm at the 28 East Gallery. "Afternoon-The Delaware." An oil painting by Pat is on exhibit at the Artists of Yardley Members Exhibit until June 4.
