Come join us on Saturday, May 13th, from 9:30 to 11:30 AM for a demonstration in oil painting by artist Philip Carroll!

"I do not choose the subjects that I paint, they choose me. I just happen upon them in my endless wandering for inspiration and they appear when I least expect them. Although I have painted landscapes in oil of city scenes and stop lights in urban settings, they were always a close-cropped view of a scene. So, for the first



time in many years I have been reborn as an artist and am finding endless joy in creating paintings that seem to make perfect sense."

Philip J. Carroll is a professional artist, lecturer, and is currently the Curator of Exhibitions for the Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown and Collingswood, NJ. He grew up in Haddonfield, NJ, and lives with his family in Collingswood where he has been a long-term resident. He teaches watercolor for the Perkins Center for the Arts, and also teaches for the Mainline Art Center in Haverford, PA. Mr. Carroll is a 1984 graduate of the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts in Philadelphia, and studied Art History at the University of Pennsylvania.

His most recent exhibitions include an invitational group exhibition at the Monmouth Museum in Monmouth, NJ in 2016, Artists of Yardley Group Exhibition in Yardley, PA in 2016, and the Perkins Center for the Arts in 2016.
