RJ Haas, facilitator doing Acrylic Resist on Paper Workshop A hands on presentation



All supplies to be provided at no expense to the artists.

Acrylic resist painting utilizes the versatility of acrylic medium and the nature of this plastic medium to be used as an opaque or as a transparent watercolor as a liquid acrylic on watercolor paper will soak into the paper. As a heavy medium it will stay on top of the paper. This process also allows the grain of the paper to soften the medium to allow a pastel look (soft) with the duality of a (hard) opaque look. The process is to work back and forth (hard and soft) allowing the grain of the paper to show.

In this workshop, the participants will follow step by step instructions to complete a small painting. When completed, the work will be suitable for framing.

**About the artist:** RJ Haas' interest in art started in 1963 where he studied Renaissance Art and Church Art with John Squillace of Woodbury, New Jersey. In addition, he studied with Dr. Ross Beitzel in preparation for college and Dick Loeb at various times though out early career. RJ also studied art history at Pfeiffer College, North Carolina with James Haymaker, with an emphasis on Impressionist artists. He received a Bachelor in Art in 1972.

From 1972 to 2001, he concentrated on studying artwork, producing scenic impressionist paintings.

RJ has been a member or past member of the following organizations: Burlington County Art Guild, Fleisher Memorial Art School, Philadelphia Sketch Club, Perkins Center for the Arts, Home Fine Art Gallery and Willingboro Art Alliance. In these groups, he received many honors including Merit Awards, Jurors Mentions, numerous other awards and cash prizes.





He specializes in house portraits and landscape renderings. Paintings use several rules to apply paint with the emphasis on a focal point with a depth of field, preferring to use complementary colors over structure to create a three (3) dimensional subject on a two (2) dimensional canvas.

He was also a past art instructor for the Center for the Arts and the Burlington County College associated with the Non Credit Community Enrichment Courses. He currently runs open studio.
