## President's Message July 2019

We continue our discussion on juried and judged shows

One of the most grieves violation by the principals; is size requirements. Far too often shows will have no size requirements. Only to find during intake, that there are too many pieces to be displayed. The larger pieces are then singled out and some are rejected to make room. Most of the time, this is done by the principals and not the judge. This situation is complicated even more when the show is judged and not juried.

All art work should be judged on quality and merit and not for size alone. It should be noted that in this situation; the judge, not the principals, must review all works presented and then reject the lesser quality of the works to bring the number of entrees down to the point where the remaining works can be displayed, regardless of size or who has entered.
