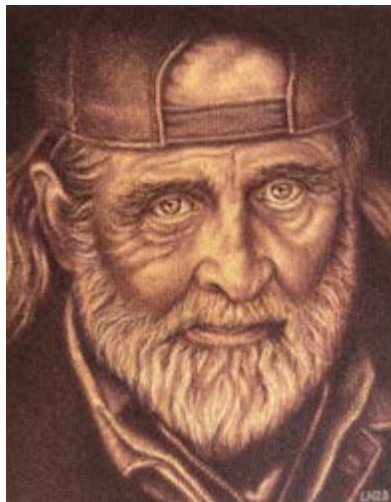

What Is Creativity, Where Can I Get Some and Is There an App for It?

Ever feel like you're out of ideas? It's all been done before? That blank sheet of paper or canvas still taunting you? A NASA study in creativity revealed that non-creative behavior is learned. Yes, you read that correctly. NON-creative behavior is learned. Can we learn to be creative again? This workshop will explore that question along with some strategies that might get us plugged back in to the flow of the creative force, or at least help us to remember a glimmer of what it felt like to be free to be creative once again.

Please bring your sketchbook or workshop notebook, fine line ink pens or gel pens, favorite pencils, erasers, and a playful mood.

David serves on the Board of the Willingboro Art Alliance, and teaches workshops, conducts monthly critiques as well as moderating figure drawing life studios.

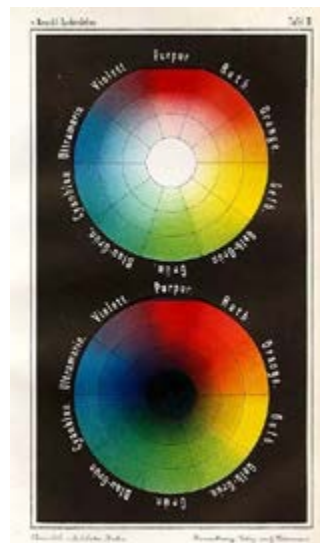

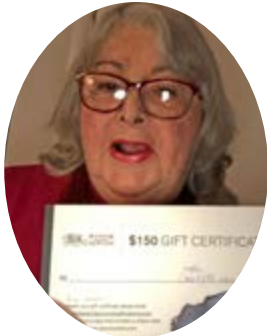
