The drying process contributes irregularities and cracks as it dries, a process reminiscent of Art Provera, Informalism, and Japanese Kintsugi. Like Japanese Kintsugi, where broken ceramics

Nancy L. Harty will introduce the basics of printmaking on a gelatin printing plate using bracers and acrylic paints. She will demonstrate how different paints respond to the plate, what papers to use, how to make interesting designs using household objects, and how the resulting prints can be used in other forms of art. Bring your inner child to this workshop to learn how to create beautiful one of a kind mono prints.



Nancy lives in Southern New Jersey with her husband, two sons, and three rescues. She was always an artist, craftsman and entrepreneur from a young age. After receiving a degree in marketing, she worked in customer service before becoming a stay at home mom raising her two boys. She utilized her marketing skills creating flyers, promotional materials and decorations for countless school fundraising events. Once the kids were both in school full-time, Nancy signed up for a mixed-media class at Perkins Center for the Arts in Moorestown. She had finally found her people. The idea of mixing paint with collage intrigued her enough that she went all in, trying all sorts of mixed media methods and materials. Her focus for the last 12 years has been creating monotype prints with a gelatin printing plate. Subject matter, themes, and colors are never predetermined, she enjoys exploration and working intuitively. The gelatin printing plate is the gym where she works out all of the struggles that life brings resulting in work that is joyful, whimsical and makes people smile. Nancy is creating a world where silly meets serious, one print at a time.



- Reception: Pending any closure due to unforeseen circumstances, a reception will be held on April 19<sup>th</sup> from 1PM to 3 PM.
- **Pickup of Artwork:** Artwork not selected for the state show must be picked up on the last day of the exhibit: Sunday, **June 23rd** from 1 PM to 3:30 PM.

#### **Artwork Display Rule:**

- Hanging artwork or photos may be no more than 28" and no less than 10" in any dimension (including matting and framing).
- All artwork must be theoriginal creation of the artist. No reproductions (such as giclee or other digital copies) of original artwork will be accepted. No work made using kits or copies of another person's artwork will be accepted.
- All works are to be delivered "show-ready." Works must be matted, framed, and wired (with screw eyes) ready for hanging. Unframed paintings on canvas must have be painted or finished edges. Artwork should be protected where necessary with Plexiglas, mylar, glass, or other clear protective material. Use of Plexiglas, not glass, is strongly recommended and it is required for any piece over 24" in any dimension.
- All work must be properly labeled on the back. Sculptures may not exceed 20" in any dimension (measurements must include any base for the sculpture) and cannot exceed 40 pounds inweight.
- Every attempt will be made to secure and protect each work submitted; the sponsoring organizations do not assume responsibility for damage incurred. Entry in this show signifies compliance of this waiver. To be eligible for the state exhibit, entry with a dollar value exceeding \$400 must have private insurance.
