Angelina Penev will lead an all day, in person, hands on, in depth pastel workshop guiding participants in creating artwork from their own photo reference (can be a landscape, still life, or even your pet!). She will discuss composition, the importance of values when creating an underpainting, mark making, blending, and layering color with hard and soft pastels. She'll also discuss sealing and give a framing demo. Bring your curiosity and passion! The workshop is good for all artistic skill levels – no experience needed.

Cost for All Day Class: \$20 for WAA members, \$40 for non-members.

Please arrive at 9:45am, the workshop runs from 10am-3:30pm with a 30 minute break for lunch (bring your own lunch and drinks).

All supplies will be provided including use of pastels, brushes/alcohol, and blending tools. It is suggested that participants use Ampersand boards which can be purchased at the workshop (or regular pastel paper will be avail at no cost). Angelina will also have reference images that can be used if participants don't bring their own.

Angelina Penev is an award winning artist who paints mainly in pastels and oils, often en plein air and alla prima. She retired from a career of critical care nursing and pharmaceutical sales. She enjoys teaching art using the principles of adult learning. She finds art a beautiful way to engage the viewer by touching their emotions while capturing a moment that will live on forever.

Angelina is a member of the Pastel Society of America, the American Impressionist Society, the Pastel Society of New Jersey, and Willingboro Art Alliance. She has studied under Jeanne Rosier Smith, Dan Gerhartz, Julian Merrow Smith, Aline Ordman, among others to expand her artistic skills. Her favorite subjects are waves, animals, landscapes and florals. She often paints alongside...and competes with her husband, Plamen.
