Fiber artist **Carolyn Harper** will host an engaging talk about her work which has a strong social justice component to it. Carolyn creates images of people or groups who have been marginalized, discriminated against, or abused. The works provide faces to those who are faceless, nameless and powerless, and bear witness to those who are suffering.

Carolyn's current works are primarily hand sewn, large quilts, often with hand dyed fabric, but she also creates hand embroidered batiks, paintings and drawings. The quilts provide very large, graphic images that call attention to those forgotten by society. Her practice is not only about documenting - it is also about making connections with people. These portraits help her subjects see themselves as not just incarcerated, or homeless, but as singular individuals with an important story and history.

Born in Rochester, NY she received her education at Kenyon College and University of Pennsylvania. She is an educator and artist who has taught art and exhibited nationally.
