Using felt pen and watercolors, **David Watson** will lead participants in exploring how to 'loosen up' when creating cityscapes scenes by just giving an impression of detail in a piece, like adding the human form to a street scene - it is not as daunting as it sounds! He will demonstrate his techniques and then the class will work individually on their own choice of reference, or work directly from imagination! Reference photos will be provided or attendees may bring their own. Core supplies like watercolor paper, pens, and basic watercolors & brushes will be available to use, but participants are encouraged to bring their own watercolors and brushes if they have them.

Award winning artist **David Watson** considers himself a history painter, born a few centuries too late. He says, "Being able to tell a story through my art is very important to me and I enjoy using my imagination to bring a character or event to life. I have been drawing for as long as I remember.
